Thank you for your support of our mission. You have made it possible for us to help the youngest members of our community and their families by being responsive to changing and emerging needs.


Through your generosity, we responded to the growing need for trauma-informed mental health services (particularly for children) by adding a second therapy space. We added an Early Intervention position to accommodate a surge in referrals following the isolation of the pandemic's early years. We responded to caregivers' need to reconnect safely by building on existing partnerships to expand playgroup offerings in larger public spaces and outdoor locations. We developed new offerings including a drop-in group for male caregivers. We continue to be a leader in parent education and advocacy efforts through our annual Force for the Future event and the Shield Our Children from Harm Conference in partnership with Dartmouth Health.

The Family Place continues to evolve and grow in the ways we connect with families and the opportunities we offer, thanks to you. We look forward to continuing to share the impact of your support.





representing mental health, education, family support and public policy.






